

### Total Coronavirus Cases in Costa Rica



Prevent collapse of hospital capacity


### **Covid-19 Mortality rate per million**



- Life-threatening conditions (PPC)
  - 4 Deaths:
    - 3 Terminal cancer
    - 1 Severe neurological impairment

- Extreme changes in the program organization
- Guidelines to address Covid-19 in children with life-threatening conditions
- Home care (12 months):
  - > 400 Home visits
  - > 60 Children died at home



# **Vaccination refusal**

- National statistics are unknown.
- National Children's Hospital:
  - 2,140 employees26 refused = 1.2%

- March/21 Costa Rica's President and Minister of Health a Regulation of National Vaccination Law from 2005:
- Mandatory Covid-19 vaccine for health workers.
- Responsibility of the employer to take measures for health workers refusing to be vaccinated.
