



### Overview

Children's Mercy is committed to providing the highest quality of care to our patients and families. To allow our RN's to work at the top of their license, the hospital is expanding the role of Medical Assistants in our ambulatory clinics and urgent care centers.

This program is designed for candidates that have recently received a MA certification but have little or no clinical experience. Our instructors will help prepare you for a career at Children's Mercy while receiving a full-time income. Upon successful completion of this 6 week paid program, employees will transition into a full-time certified MA role within CM.

### Where is the program being offered and how will it work?

Training will take place on-site at Children's Mercy

- Full-time salary provided at 32 hours a week during training.
- 6 weeks of clinicals with pediatric specific content.
- At the end of the program the MA will perform job functions, such as blood draws, injections, immunizations, dispensing medications and assisting with procedures.

### Who is eligible for the program?

This training is designed for candidates who have just graduated with their Medical Assistant certification and have less than 12 months experience in an MA role.

### Additional Requirements:

- **The application will be available beginning 4/20/2026 for the 6/15/2026 training cohort.**
- Complete interview process with the hiring leader and be selected for the training program.
- Excellent attendance is required during this 6 week training period to be successful.
- Candidates must be available to work full-time upon completion of the training program.
- Candidates should have a current MA certification within the last 12 months to qualify.
