Employees who are accepted into this program can focus on being a full-time student while receiving a full salary and tuition benefits.

We have earned the respect of physicians and nurses we work alongside each day in our areas of support such as intensive care units, medical/surgical floors, ER and clinics

Sponsorship Benefits

- All participants will receive tuition assistance up to \$5,250 per calendar year.
- Stipend payments will be paid each semester to supplement salary (not to exceed two years).
- After completing all program requirements and graduating, employees will work in a full-time Respiratory Therapist position until the work agreement requirements have been met.

Who is eligible for the program?

- Candidates must be enrolled in area accredited RT program, have completed at least one semester of the RT program and provide a letter of reference from an instructor.
- All candidates will apply and interview with RT Leadership team. If selected, employees must work in a part-time Student RT position to be eligible for the sponsorship benefits.
- Participants will review and sign a work agreement.
- Employees must remain in good standing with the hospital and their educational program.
- Participants must provide proof of enrollment and passing grades each semester.

- Hiring decisions will be made by March 2026 to start in May/June 2026
