When Brexley was only 18 days old, she stopped breathing while her family was driving in Kiowa County, Kansas. Her parents, Gracie and Kahl, dialed 911 as they tried to resuscitate their daughter.

Master Trooper Evan Jacks of the Kansas Highway Patrol answered the call and performed infant CPR until Brexley regained consciousness and started crying.

Brexley was taken to an area hospital and then transferred to a medical center in Wichita. There, an echo cardiogram revealed Brexley had heart issues, and she was transferred again to the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit at Children's Mercy Kansas City.

As the only Level IV NICU in a 200-mile radius, at Children's Mercy families have access to a full range of more than 400 newborn medicine specialists, highly trained pediatric nurses and anesthesiologists and specialized equipment for our tiniest patients.

"Without Children's Mercy, we wouldn't be where we are," said Kahl. "They have some of the biggest minds and hearts you'll ever meet."

An Innovative 2-step Treatment

Brexley went on to have two heart surgeries at the Ward Family Heart Center at Children's Mercy. The team of 35 pediatric cardiologists and heart surgeons provide nationally-recognized care for children with all types of heart conditions. The size and scope of the program means we care for some of the most complex kids, and our outcomes continue to surpass the national average.

By altering his approach and technique, Dr. Edo Bedzra, Heart Center congenital cardiac surgeon, and Director of Cardiac Surgical Innovation was able to operate

Brexley spent a couple weeks in the hospital recovering, gaining weight and lowering her blood pressure. Back home, Brexley is growing fast and sleeping well. She visits her cardiologist every two weeks to monitor her progress.


